SUMMARY: Tacoma Rail requests authorization to accept a loan from Washington State, Department of Transportation, for \$408,000 to assist with the procurement of one new 35-ton capacity boom truck for heavy locomotive component maintenance and repairs.

BACKGROUND: TPU-Rail applied for and received a loan from WSDOT for a new boom truck to support ongoing mechanical operations. The application proposed to purchase this equipment as opposed to relying on renting this type of equipment for heavy locomotive repairs. Loan agreement RRC 1010 requires Tacoma Rail to contribute \$200,000 in matching funds toward the purchase of the equipment. The loan has a 10-year term, requiring annual payments of \$40,800 beginning January 1, 2029, and includes an \$8,000 administrative fee.
