February 11	PFAS Destruction Pilot Project and Forthcoming PFAS Regulations	Tiffany Ryan, Assistant Division Manager, Environmental Services	Staff will summarize findings from a 2024 joint EPA grant-funded project -- an Environmental Services, UW Tacoma, Aquagga, and ECT2 partnership -- that evaluated the efficacy of on-site PFAS destruction at the Central Treatment Plan (CTP). Additionally, staff will provide an overview of Washington Senate Bill 5033 and its impact on the City. Passed in 2025, SB 5033 addresses PFAS in biosolids and added PFAS monitoring to the CTP's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit.
