SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:

This resolution formally adopts Tacoma 2035 as the framework for the City of Tacoma's actions for the next decade, aligning them with long-term goals in Climate & Environment, Community Safety, Housing & Homelessness, Jobs & Economy, Placemaking & Experience, and Transportation & Mobility. By adopting Tacoma 2035, the City also formally adopts the Community Safety Action Strategy, a critical strategy to advance the Tacoma 2035 Goal Area of Community Safety.

BACKGROUND:

Tacoma 2025, the first 10-year strategic vision for the City of Tacoma, established a community-driven vision that has guided the City's priorities for the past decade. This vision, and the other components of Tacoma 2025 such as the focus areas and core values, informed and provided a starting point for the development of Tacoma 2035 as the next evolution of Tacoma's strategic planning.

The adoption of Tacoma 2035 and its integrated strategies serves to align more than 40 strategies and plans being implemented across the City including cross-departmental strategies such as the Community Safety Action Strategy, the Climate Action Plan, the Transportation & Mobility Plan, the Green Economy Strategy, the Affordable Housing Action Strategy, and many more. Each of these strategies and plans support Tacoma's vision of being a safe, connected, housed, working, sustainable, and thriving community.

The adoption of Tacoma 2035 will also update the City's vision, mission, and values, improve communication and regular reporting on key initiatives, support Council decision-making in advancing Council Priorities, provide a strategic framework for budget development, and ensure the flexibility needed to reflect and respond to current and future Council direction.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT/ CUSTOMER RESEARCH:

The City conducted inclusive engagement through multilingual surveys, virtual and in-person workshops, community event pop-ups, neighborhood meetings, and collaboration with language and cultural ambassadors, resulting in nine visioning workshops, approximately 800 survey responses, 402 thematic comments, and nearly 1,600 total community inputs that informed the updated Comprehensive Plan, Tacoma 2035, and the Community Safety Action Strategy.

2025 STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

Equity and Accessibility:

One of the core values of Tacoma 2035 is "Access, Opportunity, and Belonging". This value speaks to how the City provides municipal services that support all Tacoma community members in pursuing their goals and reaching their full potential. In order to attain that goal, it is important to provide access, opportunity, and belonging for all Tacoma community members in each of the Tacoma 2035 goal areas.
