

RESOLUTION NO. 41818

BY REQUEST OF MAYOR WOODARDS, DEPUTY MAYOR DANIELS, AND COUNCIL MEMBERS BUSHNELL, HINES AND SCOTT

A RESOLUTION authorizing the one-time use of funds; execution of an agreement in the amount of \$10,000, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, to support "Go Grit Go" Football Program, a community-based empowerment program hosted by the non-profit Goose Girls.

WHEREAS, at the December 2, 2025, Study Session, Council Member Scott shared a Council Consideration Request to authorize the one-time use of \$10,000 from the Council Contingency Fund to support "Go Grit Go" Football Program, and

WHEREAS the program will host multiple skill clinics in the City that teach football fundamentals, along with leadership and mentorship workshops, guest speakers from the Tacoma Grit professional women's football team, and team building and community events in a safe, positive, and empowering atmosphere for young people, and

WHEREAS the program will be open to girls ages 8-18 interested in learning, growing, and becoming part of a powerful sisterhood through football, and

WHEREAS the program is also designed to foster cultural inclusion, celebrate diversity, and promote unity for young people both on and off the field, and

WHEREAS the City's funding for the Go Grit Go Football Program would help advance key priorities identified in the 2025 Strategic Plan, such as improving health outcomes and increasing the number of quality out of school time learning opportunities distributed equitably across the city, and

WHEREAS Goose Girls will also include placement of the City logo on event posters and citywide promotional materials, and

WHEREAS funding would help provide the following:

- (1) Free participation for young women ages 8-18;
- (2) Resources for training, such as footballs, cones, flags, and tackling bags;
- (3) Marketing and promotional materials;
- (4) Location resources, food, and drinks for participants;
- (5) Instruction and mentoring from professional coaches and players;
- (6) T-shirts for participants; and

WHEREAS City staff will negotiate and execute an agreement for services, with terms and deliverables for the City's contribution, as well as a financial report provided to the City which shows the source(s) of the funding prior to receiving the \$10,000 contribution, and

WHEREAS RCW 35.34.250 and 35.34.260 authorize a withdrawal from the Council Contingency fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent of which could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of adopting the budget, and

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less than six members of the Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund; Now, Therefore,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the foregoing Recitals are hereby adopted as the City Council's legislative findings.

Section 2. That one-time funding in the amount of \$10,000, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, is hereby approved for the purpose of supporting "Go Grit Go" Football Program.

Section 3. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to confirm deliverables with the "Go Grit Go" Football Program for the purposes hereinabove enumerated, and document as appropriate.
