**SUMMARY:**

The Community Vitality and Safety Committee will interview and may recommend up to five applicants to the full City Council for reappointment to the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority Board. **BACKGROUND:**

Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority Board (Board), among other things, administers loans to a variety of clients including low-income Tacoma families who need help buying or repairing their homes; developers who provide multi-family housing to low-income families; businesses which create jobs or rehabilitate blighted commercial space; and non-profit organizations that provide services to the Tacoma community.

**ISSUE:**

Positions need to be filled on the Board.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

The Board will continue to operate without full membership.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff requests that the Community Vitality and Safety Committee recommend the reappointment of up to five applicants to the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority Board, which will be forwarded to the full City Council in February 2026.
