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RESOLUTION NO. 41786

A RESOLUTION relating to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and the Tacoma Police Union, Local 6, I.U.P.A., Commissioned Unit, regarding the continuation of employee health and welfare benefits.

WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and the administration, and

WHEREAS Resolution No. 41341, adopted January 16, 2024, authorized the execution of the three-year Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the City of Tacoma and the Tacoma Police Union, Local 6, I.U.P.A., Commissioned Unit, ("Union"), on behalf of the employees represented by said Union, and

WHEREAS the City and the Union have negotiated a Letter of Agreement ("LOA") to the CBA which provides for the continuation of employee health and welfare benefits, and

WHEREAS the agreement currently covers approximately 308 budgeted, full-time equivalent positions, and

WHEREAS the City will continue to pay the full premium cost for dental and vision insurance for eligible full-time employees, and employee premium contributions toward medical insurance coverage remains unchanged, and

WHEREAS plan design changes include the incorporation of various state and federal mandates as well as enhanced care management services under the Regence BlueShield health plans; and also includes language regarding enhancements implemented to the City of Tacoma Wellness Program, and



WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and the Tacoma Police Union, Local 6, I.U.P.A., Commissioned Unit, said document to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
