



RESOLUTION NO. 41997

1 A RESOLUTION relating to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a
2 Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and the
3 Tacoma, Washington, City and Pierce County Employees Local Number 120
4 of the Washington State Council of County and City Employees, AFSCME,
AFL-CIO, regarding title changes for the classifications of Buyer and Buyer,
Senior.

5 WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective
6 bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and
7 the administration, and

8
9 WHEREAS Resolution No. 41922, adopted June 2, 2026, authorized the
10 execution of the three-year Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the
11 City of Tacoma and the Tacoma, Washington, City and Pierce County Employees
12 Local Number 120 of the Washington State Council of County and City Employees,
13 AFSCME, AFL-CIO, ("Union"), on behalf of the employees represented by said
14 Union, and

16 WHEREAS the City and the Union have negotiated a Letter of Agreement
17 ("LOA") to the CBA regarding title changes for the classifications of Buyer and
18 Buyer, Senior, and

19 WHEREAS the LOA provides for the following title changes:

Code	Current Title	Code	Revised Title
0304	Buyer	0304	Contracting and Procurement Specialist
0307	Buyer, Senior	0307	Contracting and Procurement Specialist, Senior



1 WHEREAS the retitling shall not affect the job duties of employees in these
2 classifications, nor shall it affect any employment conditions or seniority provisions
3 within the CBA between the City and the Union, and
4

5 WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated
6 by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

8 That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the
9 Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and the Tacoma,
10 Washington, City and Pierce County Employees Local Number 120 of the
11 Washington State Council of County and City Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO,
12 regarding title changes for the classifications of Buyer and Buyer, Senior, said
13 document to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the
14 City Clerk.
