SUBJECT: Resolution - Approve WSDOT Zero-Interest Loan RRC 1010 Award for 35-Ton Boom Truck

DATE: October 21, 2025

SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:

Tacoma Rail requests authorization to accept a zero-interest loan from the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT), in the amount of \$408,000, budgeted from Tacoma Rail Fund 4500, to assist with acquisition of one 35-ton boom truck for heavy locomotive maintenance and repairs.

BACKGROUND:

This Department's Recommendation is Based On: Having been awarded a zero-interest loan for the purchase of a 35-ton boom truck to for heavy locomotive maintenance and repair, eliminating the need for rental of this equipment. Loan Agreement No. RRC 1010 is in the principal amount of \$400,000, requires ten annual payments of \$40,800 beginning January 1, 2029, and includes an \$8,000 administrative fee. Additionally, Tacoma Rail is required to contribute \$200,000 in matching funds toward the completion of the project.
