**A. 717 Pacific Ave
Security Gate**

Vice-Chair Baersten moved that the Landmarks Preservation Commission approve the application for installation of a security gate at 717 Pacific Avenue as presented, finding that the proposal is consistent with the applicable design guidelines as included in the analysis. **B. 1117 Broadway (Ted Brown Building)
Security Gate**
