SUMMARY:
On April 22, 2026, Public Works Engineering staff will provide the Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability (IPS) Committee with an update on the design and funding status for the Schuster Parkway Trail Project.

BACKGROUND:
In June of 2024, the IPS Committee previously reviewed the project scope of work and level of design that the design specific funding at that time could cover. The IPS committee supported the level of design achievable with the design funding for the preferred Elevated Promenade/trail baseline concept alternative and alignment that was previously affirmed by IPS Committee in March of 2022. Since then, a contract has been executed with the current project consultant to design the Schuster Parkway Trail up to a 30% level. Currently design efforts have progressed to the 10% design and the project team is giving an update on their design progress.
