



RESOLUTION NO. 41903

1 A RESOLUTION relating to jail housing and services; authorizing the execution of
2 an amendment to Contract No. CW258351 with the Nisqually Indian Tribe,
3 in the amount of \$4,831,162, budgeted from the General Fund, to extend
4 jail housing and services, for an amount not to exceed \$5,331,162,
retroactive to April 1, 2026, through April 1, 2028, with the option to renew
for up to five additional one-year periods.

5 WHEREAS in April of 2023 the City and the Nisqually Indian Tribe ("Tribe")
6 entered into an agreement under Contract No. CW258351 ("Contract") for the
7 Tribe to provide jail housing and services for offenders who have violated the
8 Tacoma Municipal Code ("TMC"), and
9

10 WHEREAS the Contract had an effective date of April 1, 2023, for an initial
11 amount of \$500,000, and a termination date of April 1, 2026, with automatic
12 renewals thereafter unless either party provides written notice to terminate the
13 agreement, and

15 WHEREAS the Nisqually Jail has been an essential and cost-effective
16 partner for the City in housing and providing services to justice involved
17 individuals, and

18 WHEREAS the City now desires and the Tribe agrees to amend the
19 Contract by extending the term of the Contract and adding funding, and
20

21 WHEREAS this amendment will extend the Contract through April 1, 2028,
22 with automatic renewals annually for a period of five years after April 1, 2028, and
23 increase the compensation under the Contract by \$4,831,162 to a total of
24 \$5,331,162, and

services, for an amount not to exceed \$5,331,162, retroactive to April 1, 2026,
through April 1, 2028, with the option to renew for up to five additional one-year
periods, as more specifically set forth in the document on file in the office of the
City Clerk.
