#### SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:

A resolution authorizing a Council Contingency Fund expenditure in the amount of \$25,000 to support Tacoma Community House and the administration of the Year of Belonging Initiative.

#### **COUNCIL SPONSORS:**

Mayor Victoria Woodards and Council Members Jamika Scott and Sandesh Sadalge

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On September 9, 2025, the Mayor's Office announced the establishment of the Year of Belonging in partnership with Tacoma Community House and the Tacoma Public Library. Year of Belonging is a year-long initiative, beginning on Welcoming Week in 2025 (September 12-21, 2025) and extending through Welcoming Week in 2026.

The Year of Belonging initiative is a series of events, community convenings and discussions, as well as a communications campaign to proactively promote the feeling of belonging for every resident of Tacoma. The Year of Belonging will specifically cultivate belonging among our immigrant and refugee community, our BIPOC community, our LGBTQIA + community and all residents to embrace collective unity.

Tacoma Community House is a nationally recognized non-profit serving the immigrant and refugee community of Tacoma, as well as long-time residents seeking education, support, and pathways out of poverty. Tacoma Community House also provides extensive victim-advocacy and youth engagement programming.

There have already been three successful events under the umbrella of the Year of Belonging including a community convening and discussion, as well as an educational symposium and lunch both hosted and supported by Tacoma Community House. This year's Tacoma Reads program was also in partnership with the Year of Belonging, featuring an author interview with Valerie Kaur and a large community event produced by the Tacoma Public Library.

Funding will support costs such as production of community events, advertising and program printing, invitations and mailers, production of an initiative website, and resources for community members served by Tacoma Community House.

# **COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT/ CUSTOMER RESEARCH:**

Tacoma Community House has been independently convening, producing, and marketing the Year of Belonging and completing extensive outreach to the community they serve as well as the general public. Tacoma Public Library has also been promoting events and has completed the initial production of an initiative website that provides users access to information as well as a calendar of initiative events. This funding will support the ongoing work of Tacoma Community House in the administration of this initiative and allow for broader outreach and communications strategy.
